BACKGROUND

Dr. Darrell Krueger has served as president of Winona State University since 1989 and will be retiring from that position on July 17, 2005. In accordance with the Personnel Plan for Minnesota State Colleges and Universities Administrators, "Upon completion of service as vice chancellor for academic affairs or a president, the Board may appoint an individual as "Distinguished Senior Fellow for Academic Affairs'." At this time the Chancellor is recommending Dr. Krueger for the position of distinguished senior fellow for academic affairs following his presidency through August 9, 2005.
